YOUTH CLUB WORKER – Truth For Youth Club

2.5 hours per week on a Friday – 5:45pm – 8:15pm

Truth For Youth Club offers all students a variety of activities, from indoor projects, games and workshops. And outdoor sports that challenge their physical and mental wellbeing, to improve and enhance their confidence and self-esteem. A Youth Club Worker is required to work closely with the team to provide a programme of activities, outside school hours (ie evenings and weekends).

Truth For Youth is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young adults and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment. This post is conditional on two references, an enhanced DBS Clearance and Registration, and medical clearance. Truth For Youth is an Equal Opportunities employer.

- You must be willing to work closely with young people, encourage their participation in activities and support them in their development.
- You need to enjoy working with young people.
- You must be patient and avoid a traditional attitude towards discipline.
- You must be non-judgemental and avoid imposing your personal beliefs on young people.
- You must be able to attend all training and volunteering dates shown.
- You must be willing to undergo a Criminal Records Bureau Enhanced Disclosure Check.
- The willingness to dedicate a minimum of 6 months commitment.
- You must be available at least once a fortnight.

THE BENEFITS OF VOLUNTEERING?

This voluntary experience will provide an excellent opportunity not only for the young people who attend the Youth Club, but also for your own personal development.

As part of this opportunity you will receive:

- A reference for use in conjunction with your CV after 3 months.
- The chance to develop new friendships with colleagues and fellow youth workers/volunteers.
- The opportunity to work and influence the lives of young people between the ages of 12 and 17 years and to personally mentor a young person.
- Regular support and skills development from Senior Youth Workers.
- The opportunity to work with a group of inspirational youth leaders and learn transferable project management and administrative skills.
- Free training opportunities in various courses to support your youth work journey with CPD online.
